


Phase 2 of Building Project (2016-2019)

Plans for Phase 2 of our school building project are already underway. Site surveys and investigations have commenced. Traffic Management on Campus



Many thanks to all parents/guardians for your full co-operation regarding the traffic management on our new campus. We really appreciate your support in this matter.

There are many reasons for limiting the amount of vehicular traffic on the campus. These include:

- The Health & Safety of all students
- * The lack of car parking spaces to accommodate parents/guardians parking during drop-offs and collections
- * The fact that Phase 2 will commence shortly and Coláiste De Lacy may have very limited outside space and may need to use the actual driveways! Further details will follow as soon as we have a building schedule and safety plan for the construction period in place
- * The exceptionally high number of students being driven to school in Ashbourne
- * The inability of the campus to cope with further increases in traffic, for example, there are currently approximately 600 pupils between all three schools. This will grow very quickly to over 2000!!!

Please note the following:

- * We strongly encourage all students to walk or cycle to school (unless they travel by bus). It is recommended that all teenagers should get 30-60 minutes of exercise each day. Students have school jackets to protect them from poor weather. There are lots of bike racks at the front of the Coláiste.
- * All students who are driven to school by car should be dropped off and collected in Donaghmore-Ashbourne GAA car park or at a safe point on the route to school. The distance from the front door of the Coláiste to the pedestrian bridge (across to Donaghmore-Ashbourne GAA) is 319 metres.
- * The only vehicles permitted to drive onto the campus during opening and closing times are staff cars and school buses. This remains in place until further notice
- Parents/guardians who wish to collect their son/daughter for necessary appointments may drive onto the campus to do so and sign the student out at the office as normal. This applies only during class times only.
- * If a student is on crutches or in a wheelchair, then parents/guardians are permitted to drive onto campus to drop-off and collect students.
- * A one way system is in operation around the campus. Please obey the road markings if you have reason to drive onto the campus.
- * Please watch out for all of our students when driving and parking on campus.
- * Please refrain from dropping students off on the roundabout.
- * All students need to adjust their departure times to ensure that they arrive in the Coláiste (not just at the gates) before 8:30am. Students need sufficient time to go to their lockers and to organise themselves for their lessons.
- * Unfortunately, the Coláiste is not in a position to open the gates into Johns Wood at present. The land on the other side of the fence/gates is privately owned. The Coláiste is hoping that Meath County Council may secure pedestrian access for our campus community in the near future.
- * In addition, students who walk across the field (between Johns Wood and the campus) are trespassing on private property. Until pedestrian access to Johns Wood is secure, Coláiste De Lacy advises all students to walk the safe route to school using the town footpaths.

We thank you in advance for your continued co-operation and support! We will notify all parents/guardians if and when there are changes to the above.
