10:00 You will meet your coach and depart for **Auschwitz-Birkenau**. Journey time is approximately 1.5 hours.

You will commence a guided tour of the **Auschwitz and Birkenau Concentration Camp**. Dive into the challenging history that the camp holds at the onsite museum. Housing the world's largest cemetery and concentration camp of its kind, Auschwitz became infamous after World War 2 as the most notorious of the Nazis concentration camps. Located nearby the provincial Polish town of Oswiecim in Galacia it was established by order of Reichsfuhrer SS Heinrich Himmler on 27 April'1940. The name Auschwitz has become symbolic of the Holocaust and the genocide of the Jews. It was at Auschwitz in 1941 that the chemical Zyklon B was used for mass killings on a daily basis and by mid-1942, mass gassing of Jews where extermination was conducted on an industrial scale. Walk into the original gas chamber and visit the museum.

10:00 A reservation has been confirmed for a **guided tour of Wieliczka Salt Mine**. The mine, built in the 13th century, produced table salt continuously until 2007, and is one of the world's oldest salt mines still in operation. From its beginning and throughout its existence, the Royal mine was run by the Zupy Krakowskie Salt Mines, believed to be the world's 14th oldest company. Commercial mining was discontinued in 1996 due to low salt prices and mine flooding. The mine's attractions include dozens of statues and an entire chapel that has been carved out of the rock salt by the miners.
