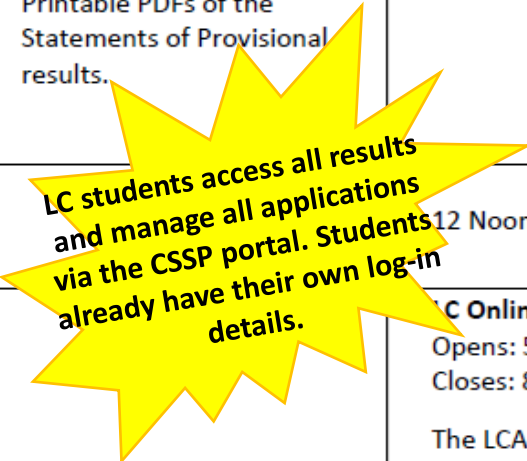

LC students will get their results **online** at 10:00am via the CSSP portal. Log in details remain the same as used previously. The school does not have these.

LC students can look at their marks and *post-marking adjustments* online via the CSSP portal.

LC students need to apply to **VIEW** their actual scripts (answer booklets) online via the CSSP portal.

LC scripts were mainly marked online. A small number of subjects were marked manually. LC students who apply to view their scripts that were marked online will be able to do so at these times.
 LC students who apply to view scripts marked manually will be allocated a time by CDL to visit the school to view them.

Note: To view **LCA** scripts, candidates complete a form (*LCA Viewing Application Form*) on the CSSP portal and email it to viewlcascript@examinations.ie

If a LC student wants to appeal a result, then need to **apply and pay (€40 per subject)** online via the CSSP portal.
